## Pastoral Ponderings

### Would You Like a Little Salt with That?

*"Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person."-Colossians 4:6*

Consider the author's words above. Now, allow yourself to consider a time when someone's words have encouraged you, discouraged you, provided you with comfort, or broke your heart. It is very rare that words have zero impact on the people to whom they are spoken. As a young boy, I can remember the first time one of my parents' friends corrected me for my misbehavior and how much fear it caused because it was so unexpected. The truth of the matter is that while we may not always remember what a person does or the exact specifics of the events, we can always remember the way a person made us feel. The power of words is long lasting. For example, Proverbs 15:4 states, "A gentle tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit." Proverbs 18:20-21 states, "From the fruit of a man's mouth his stomach is satisfied; he is satisfied by the yield of his lips. Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruits." All in all, what we say and how we say it can ultimately lead to fostering or destroying relationships... but the kicker is this; the words we speak also either lead those around us to the feet of Jesus, or they lead them away.

*"The heart of the righteous ponders how to answer, but the mouth of the wicked pours out evil things."-Proverbs 15:28*

When we are speaking to one another as brothers and sisters in Christ, it is critical that we consider the weight of our words. For example, I can remember a time when my family was living in Eau Claire and we were at church one Sunday morning. A new family was visiting the church and they had several small children with them. One of the regular attendees walked over to the couple during the service and stated, "Please find a way to control your children's volume level as it is very distracting to the rest of us." We never saw that family again. While it may seem harmless on the surface, imagine what it felt like to be that family. Were they met with the love and grace of Christ, or were they left to feel judged and unwelcome? Perhaps you can even think of a time when you have experienced something similar. In all
