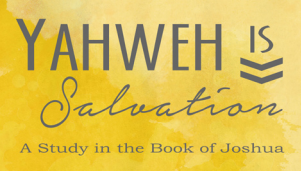

Pastoral Ponderings

“Preserve me, O God, for in you I take refuge. I say to the LORD, “You are my Lord; I have no good apart from you” (Psalm 16:1-2 ESV).

During the moments in life when everything seems to be going great we often forget that the next trial could be but a breath away. This is how I felt recently when I, metaphorically, inhaled in the land of blessing and, metaphorically, exhaled to find myself in the land of trial. Lately, God has been testing my faith as He guides me through different difficult circumstances and, sadly, I had forgotten what to do in such a situation.

As I have wrestled, trying to cast all my cares and worries unto the Lord, I have been drawn again and again to Psalm 16. I’ve read it many times and I have asked Kimmi to read it over me. David begins the Psalm at the exact right place for encouragement during challenging times. He pleads, “Preserve me God!” He declares, “God you are my refuge.” This concept has clouded my mind, in a great way, and consumed my thoughts as of late. God *is* my refuge.

When I think of God being a place of refuge my inner child comes out. I picture an ensuing army, thousands of men strong, with dark banners raised high in the air marching against a mighty fortress in the misty morning. I imagine myself standing on the battlements of a domineering castle staring down at the army knowing that there is nothing they can do to take the citadel. The enemy has never conquered this stronghold, and today is no different. This army will fail, their ladders are too short, their numbers are too few, their weapons are too frail, and their leader is too weak to overthrow the fortress of the Lord.

The enemies will try, nonetheless. They’ll launch their arrows darkening the sky. They’ll scream and shout nasty battle cries. They’ll seek to swim across the sloshing moat. They’ll ram the gate with thundering force. They will fail. The enemy will fall. The keep is unassailable. When the dust settles the walls of the Lord will stand secure, the gate will hold firm, and the enemy will have been defeated. God will preserve me.

As I have walked through these recent trials in life, I’ve asked myself, “How do I enter into the fortress of the Lord? How do I find refuge in Him?” In searching for this answer I am reminded of Psalm 16:2. David says, “God is my refuge,” and then proceeds with,

"Apart from Him I have no good at all." This helps me realize how to practically enter into the refuge that God offers. If I'm to be preserved through difficulties, then I must look away from myself. I must look to God. I must remind myself that, truly, God is good. I must remind myself that apart from Him I am dust to dust.

Several days ago I sat on my front porch next to my wife, Kimmi, staring at my feet. She knew of the struggles I faced and was right beside me for better or worse. In that moment she said, "Sometimes, when I am struggling, I find it helpful to look further out into the distance, and not right at my feet." Thank you, Kimmi. The opening verses of Psalm 16 rushed into my mind. Yes, God is my refuge, and to enter into His always and forever standing fortress I must look away from myself and into His eyes. I must look up from my feet and my failings and my worries. I must look into the physical manifestation of God's own goodness and love. I must stare at the Savior Jesus Christ and know that in Him I have found victory over every enemy. I'll stand on the battlements with Jesus and know that the enemy will fail no matter how seemingly strong or frightening. Yes, God will preserve me in life and through death to everlasting life with Him.
