Pastoral Pondering

One Body

"The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all the parts are many, they form one body. So it is with Christ. For we were all baptized by one Spirit into one body- whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free-and we were all given the one Spirit to drink." 1 Corinthians 12: 12-13

With the election season upon us already, I have listened to many debates and have heard candidates use the term "I am the only one up here who has ____". In the spirit of the election season, I can say jokingly I am the only elder who was here from the beginning of New Life's birth. Cory and I were blessed to be involved with a group of people who were looking for more out of church than just meeting for an hour on Sundays and then going our merry ways until we met again the next Sunday. When New Life first started we were contacted by a pastor who told us that most church starts fail and was wondering if we would be willing to join his church? But God did not lead us there. We started meeting in a small building on Saturday nights for worship, using videos series for our teaching. Since we met Saturday nights, we had a meal following our service because we hadn't had time to eat prior to the service and the meals after church have continued since. We called a pastor without a budget, without money and without a business plan which goes against all common sense. Surprisingly, he accepted and we were able to pay him. God continued to grow New Life and we became too large to meet at the small rural church. We moved to Dresser elementary school on Sundays and were eventually blessed to have Pastor Tony join us. We moved to our current location after God miraculously financed our move in 2012, where He also added Pastor Chandler to our family. I have skipped a lot of details but wanted to give an overview of the history of New Life because the story is one that only God would write. Who would have ever believed that a bar would be turned into a place of worship? I continue to sit and marvel at what God is doing through the people of New Life.

That leads me to the above passage. Since I have had the vantage point of being here from the beginning and witnessing God's work first hand, I have been able to see my fellow brothers and sisters in Christ using their gifts to advance His Kingdom. New Life is a body, one unit as Paul writes, that is made up of many parts with Christ as the Head. Paul goes on to state that no part is more valuable than another part. God has brought us together, people with different talents and gifts, and united us with Jesus through the Spirit. Paul makes it clear that we are ALL baptized by the Spirit into one body. We are

Let us each use our gifts willingly and joyfully to advance His Kingdom!

In closing, as I reflect on the 10 years that New Life has been in existence, I sit in awe and wonder at what God is doing with a group of common folk who are meeting in a former bar. What a crazy story, one that only our Creator and Savior could pen. As elders and pastors we are thankful for your hard work and the use of your gifts. Know this that we pray regularly for the body of New Life and please keep us and our families in your prayers as well.
