Have you ever noticed that when you enter a bookstore or library, you nearly always move toward a section of books that you've visited many times before? We tend to enjoy browsing subjects familiar to us, hoping to find something not yet read. Just think of the vast number of different subjects we walk right past! Recently, while updating the inventory list for New Life's Resource Center and checking off books one by one, I became fascinated by the great variety of titles on subjects that I've never before considered reading. Books such as "Precious Remedies Against Satan's Devices," "21 Servants of Sovereign Joy," "Grace Abounding to the Chief of Sinners," "Death by Living," "A Practical Guide to Culture," "The Problem of Pain," and "What Does the Bible Really Teach about Homosexuality" are some examples, among many more. And there are many small books written by great Puritan authors, small enough to read in one sitting. Small books are a good, easy way to check out a new author.

Besides books and CD's we have for purchasing, we can also help you find or order study books for a Bible study that you may want to share with others in our fellowship. The Resource Center exists as a ministry to bring glory to God by helping you grow in your relationship with Him. There is always so much more to learn and love about the Lord! Sharing a book you've loved with another person and talking about it with them is an easy way to share your faith, as an evangelism or discipleship tool. Also, if you don't own a study Bible and would like to have one, we have ESV study Bibles free to you for that very purpose.

I'd like to highlight a book that has truly impacted my big picture understanding of the gospel. It was written as a book for kids, one that can be read by a parent as a read aloud (as I did) or read by an older elementary or middle school child. "Grandpa's Box" by Starr Meade is the story of a grandpa who tells his two grandchildren stories from the Bible when they come to visit him in his shop. Every story is told as a battle story in God's big redemption story told throughout all of Scripture, from Genesis to Revelation. The war that began when Satan successfully tempted Adam and Eve to turn from trusting God, leading God to put a curse on Satan and to give Adam and Eve a promise that one of Eve's

offspring would one day destroy Satan and his work, has continued throughout all of history. The battle stories are told in a very captivating, true-to-Scripture way using little figures that Grandpa keeps in a small vellow box. This delightful book helped me to see the gospel more deeply from beginning to end, and how each of the Bible stories fits into it. Each chapter tells a different story from Scripture followed by a Scripture passage. I love how all the stories and Scriptures are woven together, and how Grandpa engages his two grandchildren by asking questions as he tells them. I'm currently reading it for a second time with my grandson. I think it's impossible to rehash God's redemption story too much!

Come browse our shelves any time. We love to talk about books and life and to mutually encourage each other in the Lord.


