Ministry Highlight

Transportation Ministry

In reading the weekly Sunday newsletter you have probably come across the list of ministry teams and contact information and wondered what these ministries are all about. These various ministries are simply forms of service to one another, motivated by the Gospel of Jesus Christ for the sake of glorifying God and for the building up of the body of Christ. The apostle Paul talks about this ministry in 1 Timothy 1:2, where he speaks of his service to God and others being done for “the sake of the Gospel.” According to the gospel believers are new creations in Christ, and as a part of our ‘new createdness’ we become servants in God’s kingdom, washing one another’s feet in humble service motivated by love. In this way we are counting the needs of others as more significant than our own so that the name of Jesus might be glorified in our own lives and in the lives of others.

One of these ministries to highlight this month is the transportation ministry. The transportation ministry is lead by our very own Art Behr. If you haven’t met him, you need to! He heads this ministry on wheels and delights to provide transportation to those who have no vehicle or cannot drive to Sunday service or participate in the many bible studies taking place. This ministry is extremely important to some of our dear brothers and sisters since it allows them to be able to gather with the family in Jesus. Likewise it’s extremely important for the rest of the family too because if some are hindered from fellowship than a part of the body ends up being missing and is hindered in using their gifts.

We see the immense value of being present together, especially during Sunday service, and if anyone is hindered because of lack of transportation, then as a body we want to fill that need by providing a means of transportation. You may already be doing this yourself by providing a ride for someone in need, great! However, if you or someone you know needs a ride for various reasons (i.e. injured and can’t drive, don’t have a vehicle, or no license) make sure to talk to Art. He has also made himself available for emergency situations such as someone without transportation needing to get to a doctor appointment or needing to pick up important prescriptions.

Since this is a small ministry there is always need for additional team members. If you’re interested in being on a “call list” in case there are more rides needed than Art can attend to on any given Sunday, be sure to connect with Art and give him your contact information. The need varies from month to month, so being called might not happen regularly but it’s good to have names and numbers ready. *Continued-->*

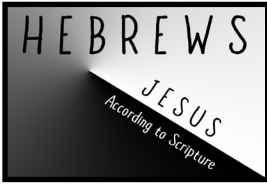
