# PASTORAL PONDERING

## The Praises (Psalms)

The Psalms, or as it is in Hebrew 'Praises,' is a book that impacts us no matter the situation we may find ourselves in. For generations people have been singing, reading, praying, and meditating on the Psalms. For the last few weeks I have been going through this book and really enjoying dissecting what is being said, and in some cases coming away with a different way of looking at a particular Psalm that has helped me on my study through the book.

The thing I enjoy the most about the Psalms is the raw emotion the authors are writing with. Nothing is held back, whether he is calling out to God in praise, or for God's justice to be done to right a wrong, or to cry out to God because it has felt to the author that everybody has abandoned him. The psalmists are not afraid that God will leave them or turn His back on them if they call out to Him. We must not be afraid either. If we think about the time period most or all of these were written in, any culture other than the Israelites would never have thought about talking to their god in such a way. They believed that if they would make the gods angry bad things would happen to them. But we see it all through the Psalms and more importantly all through the Bible, the people crying out to and having a personal relationship with the one true God by opening their hearts to reveal the true issue at hand.

In the introduction to the Psalms in the ESV bible, it states: *The book of Psalms, or Psalter, has supplied to believers some of their best-loved Bible passages. It is a collection of 150 poems that express a wide variety of emotions, including: love and adoration toward God, sorrow over sin, dependence on God in desperate circumstances, the battle of fear and trust, walking with God even when the way seems dark, thankfulness for God's care, devotion to the word of God, and confidence in the eventual triumph of God's purposes for the world.* 

That is what I love about the Psalms. I don't have to be afraid to open my heart up to God in my darkest of hours or rejoice with Him in my greatest praises. My relationship with Him is not a one-way relationship. Even in the Psalms we see hints of Jesus and the relationship that would save us, and throughout His ministry Jesus quoted and meditated on the Psalms so why shouldn't we. God is a Great God.
