Ephesians 6:10,11 says, "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of his might (is-khoos'). Put on the whole armor of God that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil."

And then praying..." for all the saints"..."And for me that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel",... (And for Tychicus)..."whom I have sent to you for the same purpose, that you might know our affairs and that he might comfort your hearts..."Eph.18-22

Acts 1:8 speaks of this power of His might, we receive after the Holy Ghost is come upon you, that you become a witness unto Jesus Christ wherever you are...Jerusalem to all ends of the earth.
