Missions

In the past months, the members of the missions team have been contemplating who the Lord is.

Is He worthy to be praised and proclaimed? Who is best to do this? These questions sparked a curiosity in our conscience that led to sharing a book by reformed pastor Tom Wells, titled "A Vision for Missions." This is a timeless book written in 1985 about the character of God and the motives for missionary work. Do you know the magnificent saving power of Jesus Christ? Then God in Christ is worthy to be proclaimed by you for who He is.

John 3:16-18 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God."

1 John 4:11 "Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another."

What greater love can we have than to lay down our lives sharing the love of God with others. Our view of God and our attitude toward missions must be God centered. "The man who knows God best is the man who best knows Jesus Christ" and is the man best equipped to tell those God puts in his path about the Glory of our great God. For the sake of our souls and those of the lost, and to the glory of God we must seek to grow in our knowledge and love of God in Christ Jesus that we might be fully equipped for every good work. "The heart of God towards the poor distressed sinner is fully unveiled at the cross. For us to be God centered means to have this same compassionate heart." This heart then compels us to have concerns for the needs of men. The greatest of these needs being the very Glory of God Himself.

Presenting examples, the book dives deep into the lives of great men of faith like David Brainerd, William Carey, and Henry Martyn. The chief end of their service was to glorify God and enjoy Him forever in Christ. He alone is our reason and purpose. This is an immutable truth. Christ is our motivation. in us to reach out to lost men and women with the good news of God's glory as seen in the face of Jesus Christ.

Missions is THE MISSION of the body therefore we must be concerned with the God of Missions. The Vision for missions is a vision of God and His Glory, in and through Jesus Christ.
