### Christianity is DONE

"And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has Life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life. I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life."

1 John 5:11-13

I know its human nature to ponder the meaning of one's life. When you are very young you may ask questions like "what's for dinner" or "what are we going to do today?" Those are the types of things that I focused on, not thinking much into the future. As I grew older, I began to ponder things like "what will I be when I grow up" and "will Cory go on a date with me on Valentine's Day" 40 plus years ago? SHE SAID YES! Now I am retired, and I'm left with the question "what's next?" I must admit that I still miss seeing everyone and I remain a little lost, trying to figure out where God has me going next! Possessing more free time gives one a chance to reflect on life. The one thing I do know - and was faced with it on a daily basis - is that life is short. What's next?

Death is inevitable. Over the 25 years here in Osceola, I unfortunately have lost patients/friends from newborns to those over 100 years old. Unfortunately, it is part of the human condition which began in the Garden of Eden but was conquered on the cross!

As Christians we have comfort in knowing that our life here is only temporary, but we have an eternal life because God gave us eternal life in His Son. I read an interesting article recently which was titled "Christianity is DONE". I assumed it was an article which would be critical of Christianity, but it was stating the obvious about our eternal life and salvation. It was written by a pastor who has
