#### **Ministry Highlight**

Thank you in advance for your support of the Building & Grounds (B&G) team!

Do you enjoy facilities that are safe, pleasant, accessible, and smooth-running? No doubt, the answer is a resounding "Yes!"; and not only do you enjoy this level of comfort, but you expect it.

It probably is no surprise that a lot of work, as well as financial resources, occur behind-the-scenes, in order to meet your expectations. There are a few dedicated individuals on the B&G team that commit themselves to this God-honoring work, while the financial part is provided by the members of New Life via your giving (general offerings).

Speaking about those financial resources, good stewardship by those who oversee B&G, and by those who perform the work, safeguards your financial contributions; in a sense, providing the most bang for the buck. Large (capital) expenses; e.g.: parking lot paving, roof replacement, are budgeted; i.e.: we have a savings account where we regularly set aside funds. Our roof is at or near its life expectancy, and a replacement could cost upwards of \$150,000.

There are lots of opportunities; some planned, some otherwise. When things are running smoothly, activities are generally proactive; i.e.: planned. An example of this would include such things as filter changes.

But emergencies (building alarm, no heat, no hot water, roof leaks) are not anticipated, and must be addressed with urgency; i.e.: they can't be delayed. For example, last winter, one dedicated individual was on our snow-covered roof multiple times tending to one of the rooftop heating units! (Fortunately, the current "non-winter" has made such activities unnecessary.) In any event, the better we are at planning, and the more volunteers we have, the fewer emergencies.

There are lots of opportunities to get involved, from plumbing to general cleanup. We certainly could use more helpers; those who step in to fill vacancies (ex: someone to perform "preventive maintenance" tasks); and those who can serve as back-ups, to relieve some of the demand on the "regulars" (ex: plumbing, HVAC).
