### *Sunday Meals Ministry*

New Life Meals are a valuable part of our Sunday fellowship together after Sunday service. This time together allows members, visitors and guests an opportunity to visit together, to foster creative ministry ideas and plans, to exchange experience's, to share personal and spiritual needs. And often brings the church community and extended community together creating a stronger sense of community and family.

These meals are put together by meal teams. The Sunday Meal Ministry is made up of 8 teams and each team will serve 6 times during the year. Volunteers on the meal teams serve by bringing and serving food as well as clean-up. The teams can always use extra hands to participate with clean up. Emptying garbage containers, checking family center and class rooms for trash, sweep floors, wipe down tables, wash dishes and wipe off counters. Each team takes on a big roll each Sunday, and we want it to be a joyful service so extra helping hands are always welcomed. This is a good way for the teens to get involved.

No meal on the following Sunday, June 11<sup>th</sup>, a regular scheduled meal team meal on the 25<sup>th</sup>. Every other Sunday we will have a meal thru August.
