Ministry Highlight

There are many vital ministries here at New Life that seek to bless the body of Christ with the gifts each one has been given in order that the name of Jesus might be exalted and the body might grow up in maturity and love. There are also ministries hosted at the New Life building, one of these ministries being MOPS. The mission of MOPS International is to encourage and equip moms of young children to realize their calling as mothers, women, in relationship to Jesus, and in partnership with the local church. They do this through building relationships with one another and studying the Word together. MOPS seeks to build up moms and to encourage a deeper relationship with Jesus, so that they too can teach their children about Jesus. They seek to sow seeds of the Gospel in their children through the excellent MOPS KIDS program.

Here in the St. Croix Valley, MOPS welcomes all moms and is not represented or supported by any one church, but rather by many working together for His Kingdom's growth. God has been faithful in our rapidly growing opportunity to connect with moms.

This year's theme is Find Your Fire. The key verse is "Never let the fire go out ... When you hope, be joyful. When you suffer, be patient. When you pray, be faithful. Share with God's people who are in need. Welcome others into your homes." (Romans 12:11-13)

As a group, they have meetings two times a month that consist of meals, speakers, crafts, fellowship, videos, games, meaningful conversation, and there is always childcare included. They also have playdates, Moms' Night Outs, and fund-raisers that offer added community throughout the year.

Here are some of the goals for MOPS in the St. Croix Valley (which are also great ways that you can be praying for the ministry). They desire for consistent attendees to gain depth in relationship and ministry and to genuinely grow deeper in knowing Jesus. They also desire to wisely steward what God has given them, so pray for sustainable finances or a clear, realistic, and attainable path toward them. Reaching out to moms from the community is vital to their ministry as most moms come to MOPS via word of mouth.

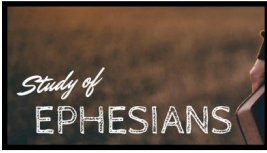
