WALK IN THE SON

In his letter to the church in Ephesus, Paul goes to great lengths to show that believing Gentiles are fellow heirs and members of the body of Christ (Ephesians 3:6). While they had formerly been Gentiles in the flesh, separated from God, now through the blood of Jesus they have been reconciled to Him (Ephesians 2:12-13). Paul uses a fair amount of ink in the latter portion of this letter instructing them on how to live for and in Christ.

"Now this I say and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds. ¹⁸ They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart. ¹⁹ They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedy to practice every kind of impurity. ²⁰ But that is not the way you learned Christ!— ²¹ assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the truth is in Jesus, ²² to put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires, ²³ and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, ²⁴ and to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness" ~Ephesians 4:17-24.

The apostle begins the passage above by exhorting them not to walk as the Gentiles do (and as they did while unbelieving Gentiles). He describes the thoughts and inclination of the unbelieving Gentile minds as useless, futile because their minds were darkened in understanding. Verses 19-22 gives us a vivid description of the corruption that produces hardness of the heart. Paul tells us that it this hardness of heart that causes the futility of mind, ignorance, and alienation from the life of God.

He expresses a similar thought in Romans 8:6-7 regarding the mind: "For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace." For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot."

Thankfully the intense light of the Gospel illumines darkened minds and softens hard hearts that we might see Christ. Paul goes on in Ephesians 4:22-24 to describe that those who come to Jesus are renewed in the spirit of their minds (see also Romans 12:2), and they are to put away the old self and put on the new self. This new self is "created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness." What a staggering gift we have been given! No longer walking in sin but rather we walk in the light of the glory of Christ!

"Walk" seems to be one of Paul's favorite words to use in his letters. Since the Ephesians weren't to walk as the Gentiles, we should look at how Christ followers were

instructed to walk.

<u>In love-</u> "Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. ² And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God" ~Ephesians 5:1-2

<u>In wisdom</u>- "Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, ¹⁶ making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. "Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is" ~Ephesians 5:15-17

In a worthy manner- "I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called" ~Ephesians 4:1

In the good works prepared for usworkmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them" Ephesians 2:10

As children of light- "for at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light" ~Ephesians 5:8


